"THE BLUE SHEET" Journey in the Word 2022 58th Edition: Sept 5 – Nov 27 Fall Edition

Welcome to the 58th edition of "The Blue Sheet Readings!" This edition will take us through the fall up to the First Sunday in Advent which begins on November 27th.

This edition is like previous editions in that on Sundays we follow the Revised Common Lectionary Year C until the First Sunday in Advent which will begin Year A.

Our readings will focus on the Gospel of Matthew. We will begin with the context and calling of Matthew to follow Jesus in Mark and Luke's Gospel. Please take notice of the people who are feasting at Matthew's house immediately after Jesus calls him. Notice the views of the Pharisees. And now consider that part of Matthew's purpose in writing his gospel is to show/convince and announce to the Jewish people that the Messiah, the Anointed One has come in the person of Jesus and has also fulfilled numerous prophecies. (Of course, Matthew records his calling as well – 9:9-13)

Pay attention to the themes and the people who are ministered to by Jesus. Consider their backgrounds and the contextual setting in which Matthew shares his Gospel.

This is significant and will deepen your readings during the Advent season which will close this edition of the Blue Sheet and open the next edition of the Blue Sheet.
