Let's continue to be in the Word as we give space for the Word (and the WORD) to be in us. As has been our practice, this edition follows the Revised Common Lectionary (RCL) **Year A** for Sunday readings

In this edition, we will spend time in the Gospel of Luke. By and large, we will engage a "slow read" of Luke's narrative journey. We do that for many reasons...1) I feel that during these disruptive days, it is vitally important that we focus on the journey and words of Jesus, 2) at times our familiarity with the text can lead us to a very brief read and not spend the time we need to "soak" in the passage and be engaged by the passage, 3) we need to consider what Luke is trying to reveal – who are the people involved in the passage: how does Jesus respond to the various circumstances/people/events within that particular passage: how does this passage engage us, the reader in 2026 and how do we then respond?

On occasion, we will sort of "jump around" in order to help us with the context of our Lenten journey and the events which are at hand. I'm sure you will understand as we journey together. We will also highlight special days (different than Sunday) as we walk through this edition. We will not quite finish the entire Gospel of Luke but we will continue our reading through Luke in the next edition.

These readings have all been the result of prayer & discernment. The encouragement is to be deeply mindful of your faith journey together within community and that you would find place and space to journal your discoveries, especially taking time to share with others, for all of Scripture is to be read/heard and discovered within community.

Therefore, please share your discoveries with others. Enjoy spending time in the Word this season and we pray that the Word will spend time in you! Maybe you would be able to begin journaling – in your own style...a good spiritual discipline to follow as well. Thx – pk!
